





Answer: William Henry Harrison. In 1811, while serving as governor of the Indiana Territory, Harrison battled against Indian chief Tecumseh and his Shawnee warriors in the brutal Battle of Tippecanoe. Harrison's forces defeated the Indians, and soon after he acquired the nickname Old Tippecanoe. When Harrison teamed up with vice presidential candidate John Tyler in 1840, the rallying cry for the Whigs became "Tippecanoe and Tyler, too!"
