Answers to Frequently asked Questions

- We can arrange group vaccine clinics for 10 or more people. Depending on your location and the vaccines needed, we may be able to come to your location. The administrative fee is discounted for groups. Please call at least two weeks prior to the proposed vaccine event.
- We are able to provide prescriptions for medication to prevent malaria. There is an additional fee for this service of \$20.
- We provide travel vaccines for children such as typhoid, yellow fever and hepatitis A.
- What you should bring to your visit immunization record and itinerary.
- We do not file insurance.
- Most travelers need Hepatitis A vaccine and a tetanus booster within the past 10 years.
- Hepatitis B vaccine is recommended for travelers expecting exposure to blood or body fluids.
- Yellow Fever vaccine is required for travel to some countries in South America and Africa. You may find a complete list on the CDC traveler's webpage.
- Typhoid vaccine is recommended for most developing countries.
- Japanese Encephalitis and Rabies vaccines are recommended for certain groups of travelers.
