Protect yourself and your family from vaccine-preventable diseases with immunizations. Immunizations begin at birth and continue throughout a person's life.

Life-threatening symptoms

These diseases may cause symptoms like body aches, fever or rash, and even life-threatening symptoms such as swelling of the brain, liver disease and death.

Protect yourself against disease

Immunizations protect you from vaccine-preventable diseases, such as diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, measles, mumps, rubella, polio, varicella (chickenpox), hepatitis A, hepatitis B, haemophilus influenza type b (HIB), meningitis, influenza and pneumonia.
