We've Got Your Number...



It starts simple enough. Your phone rings, you pick up and somebody introduces themself as "Deputy So and So". He says you've missed a Grand Jury summons and a warrant is about to be issued for your arrest. However, you do have the option to pay a fee instead of having the warrant issued. Usually this sum of money will be paid via a Green Dot prepaid debit card.

It's a scam!

Unfortunately, these kinds of calls make their rounds in Tarrant County pretty frequently. Callers tend to disguise themselves as Tarrant County Sheriff's Office Deputies, even using names of current or former employees. Please be wary of these types of scam calls.

TCSO never makes any calls concerning Jury Duty. When making phone calls, Deputies clearly state their name, why they are calling, and give a geniune number that they can be reached at.

If you ever feel like you've gotten a suspicious call, you can call the TCSO Admin Desk at 817-884-3099. We can tell you if you've be the victim of a suspected scam call or if you have been speaking to a TCSO Deputy.
