

EMERGENCY FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE (OTHER) STANDARDS OF CARE

DEFINITION

Emergency Financial Assistance-Other (EFA-Other) provides limited short-term payments, up to 90 days within a single grant year, and includes reassessment of emergency status every 30 days. This service standard is designed to assist a HRSA RWHAP client with an urgent need for essential items or services necessary to improve health outcomes, including: utilities (inclusive of electricity, gas, water, telephone, or internet access), housing, and/or food (inclusive of groceries and food vouchers).

In addition to the above outlined essential items, and outside of the aforementioned 90-day timeframe, EFA-Other may also be used to provide a prepaid cellphone with up to three- months' worth of prepaid phone/data cards.

EFA-Other must occur as a direct payment to an agency or through a voucher program. Direct cash payments to clients are not permitted. During a national, state, and/or locally declared emergency, current service standard definitions and caps may be waived by the Administrative Agency.

GOAL

Provide short-term payments to assist with emergency housing, expenses related to utilities, and/or food assistance when other regional resources have been used and/or exhausted.

STANDARD OF CARE

Hiring Standards

All program staff should meet Health Resources and Services
 Administration(HRSA) Standards requirements for staff qualifications.

Training Standards

 All program staff should abide by the HRSA Standards requirements for training.

Job Performance Standards

- All program staff should abide by the HRSA Standards requirements for job performance.
- The agency must establish an eligibility policy for clients to utilize funds and to define emergency.

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- Program staff must develop a plan of action with each client with the goal of preventing future emergency financial needs.
- The agency must have a policy for re-evaluating emergency situations.

Reporting

• All program staff should abide by the HRSA Standards requirements for reporting.

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
