It is requested that the Commissioners Court receive and file the Auditor's Report for the Tarrant County Sheriff's Commissary Operations for Fiscal Years 2022 and 2023.

BACKGROUND

In accordance with the Local Government Code Section 351.0415, "Commissary Operation by Sheriff or Private Vendor," the Auditor's Office examined the Tarrant County Sheriff's Office commissary operations for fiscal years 2022 and 2023. Specifically, we reviewed general ledger receipt and disbursement accounts as shown on the attached financial statements and found the commissary accounts fairly represent the Sheriff's Office commissary operations for the fiscal years ending September 30, 2022, and September 30, 2023.

As required by Texas Government Code 511.016, the Auditor's Office will forward the audit report and a Jail Operations Summary of Revenues and Expenditures for fiscal years 2022 and 2023.

SUMMARY

In accordance with Texas Local Government Code Section 351.0415, "Commissary Operation by Sheriff or Private Vendor", the Auditor's Office examined the Tarrant County Sheriff's Office commissary operations for Fiscal Year 2022 and Fiscal Year 2023. The objectives of the audit were to determine whether the account balances on the attached financial statements were materially correct and financial controls were adequate to ensure that assets were adequately safeguarded. In our opinion, the attached financial statements for Fiscal Year 2022 and Fiscal Year 2023, presented fairly commissary operations, in all material respects. We also found that financial controls were generally adequate to ensure assets were safeguarded.

Furthermore, we followed-up on prior audit observations and recommendations made in the audit report presented to Commissioners Court on February 7th, 2023. Based on our review, we found that Observations 2 and 3 were fully implemented. Observation 1 is substantially complete. The Auditor's Office will continue to assist the Sheriff's Office with reviewing the security matrix provided by the contractor to ensure no conflicts exist.
