2018 Annual Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA) Data Report, Findings and Corrective Action

In accordance with 115.388 Prison Rape Elimination, Tarrant County Juvenile Services (TCJS) is required to collect, aggregate and publish all sexual abuse and sexual harassment data from our Pre-Adjudication facility. Tarrant County Juvenile Services also has the same data requirement for all contracted placement facilities required to be PREA compliant.

Tarrant County Juvenile Services

There were no sexual abuse and sexual harassment incident data for our Pre-Adjudication facility for 2018.

The following numbers for CY2018 will be reported to the Bureau of Justice Statistics (BJS) in accordance to the PREA definitions and categories as follows:

- There were 0 allegations of Youth on Youth Non-Consensual Sexual Acts
- There were 0 allegations of Youth on Youth Abusive Sexual Contact
- There were 0 allegations of Youth on Youth Sexual Harassment
- There were 0 allegations of Staff Sexual Misconduct both were Unfounded
- There were 0 allegations of Staff Sexual Harassment

Progress in the Prevention of, Detection of and Response to Sexual Abuse and Sexual Harassment

TCJS mandates zero tolerance toward all forms of sexual abuse and sexual harassment. In a continued effort to maintain compliance with PREA standards and to remain proactive in the prevention of sexual abuse and sexual harassment, TCJS ensures the following:

- TCJS completed its first PREA audit April 2016 and after completion of the corrective action items, became PREA certified in October 2016.
- TCJS has implemented the policies, procedures and practices required by PREA Standards.
- TCJS is in the process of undergoing their second PREA audit. The on-site audit is scheduled for October 28, 2019.
- We continue to provide PREA training to employees, volunteers and vendors who have contact with residents.
- Department administrators continue to conduct unannounced rounds in all facilities, on all shifts.
- A Behavior Screening is conducted on all residents at intake and throughout the resident's detainment to reduce the risk of sexual abuse by or upon a resident.
- All residents receive comprehensive education on sexual safety and TCJS policies related to sexual abuse and harassment.


- All allegations of sexual abuse and sexual harassment are investigated by specially trained staff investigators. Any conduct that appears to be criminal is reported to law enforcement.
- TCJS maintains an MOU with the Women's Center of Tarrant County to provide supportive services to resident victims of sexual abuse.

TCJS Contract Residential Facilities


TCJS currently has contracts with 24 residential facilities. All our contract facilities are required to comply with PREA Standards in TCJS contract language, if applicable. In July 2016, our agency began obtaining incident-based data on sexual abuse and sexual harassment from our contract facilities. This data will be published on our agency website and a comparison of data will be conducted in the Annual Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA) Data Report. Tarrant County Juvenile Services will continue to monitor our contract placement facilities in their efforts to comply with PREA standards.


