## $\sqrt[4]{4}$



- Whites have higher death rates for heart disease than Hispanics, Asians and American Indians. ${ }^{1}$
- African American death rates for heart disease were 20 percent higher than those for Whites. ${ }^{2}$
- Fifty-three percent of black women are overweight, compared to 52 percent of Mexican-American women and 34 percent of White women. ${ }^{3}$
- African-Americans have a high incidence of hypertension, a leading risk factor for heart disease. ${ }^{4}$
- African-Americans also tend to develop high blood pressure younger than other groups. ${ }^{5}$
